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## REQUESTS FOR QUOTATION – 2025-06 ANNUAL PULVERIZE & PAVE

The Township of Nipigon is issuing this Request For Quotation (RFQ) to Pulverize & Pave the 700 square meter (m<sup>2</sup>) intersection of Bell St & 5<sup>th</sup> St in Nipigon Ontario, Pulverize and Pave a 250 meter (m) section of Wadsworth Drive from (49°00'26.3"N 88°16'02.7"W) to (49°00'34.2"N 88°15'59.2"W) & Patch/Pave two 0.4 meter (m) wide by 170 meter (m) long sections of Churchill Street between existing asphalt and curb and gutter.

Proposed Scope of Work

To Pulverize & Pave approximately 700 square meters of the Bell St & 5<sup>th</sup> Street intersection and approaches. 250 m of Wadsworth Drive & 170 m of patch work on Churchill Street between existing asphalt and curb/gutter. The width of roadway to be pulverized and paved on Wadsworth Drive, and the Bell St/5<sup>th</sup> St intersection is on average is 7.0 m, with the patch areas on Churchill St. being 0.3-0.4 meters in width. The thickness of the asphalt to be placed in all areas is 50 mm of SP 12.5. It is anticipated that there will be a minimum of a 2% crown in the new asphalt. It is anticipated that there will be a +/- One (1) month delay between pulverizing and being ready to place the asphalt. After pulverizing the Township intends to make a base repair with internal forces. Contractors should anticipate separate mobilizations for the pulverizing and the paving.

Contractors are asked to provide a price for SP 12.5 and specify if 1 lift or 2. It is anticipated that the Contractor will pulverize in one (1) mobilization and demobilization; and, at a later date pave in a second mobilization and demobilization. It is expected that the successful Contractor will complete a "walk through" of the site to confirm adequacy of base prior to paving. Anticipated schedule:

Pulverize late spring early summer of 2025 Township make base repair during late spring early summer of 2025 Supply & Install all asphalt for roadway no later than Friday, September 25, 2025
